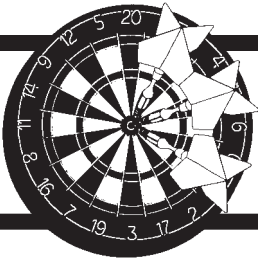

your best. I know you will find the history of the TCDA most interesting and enjoyable.

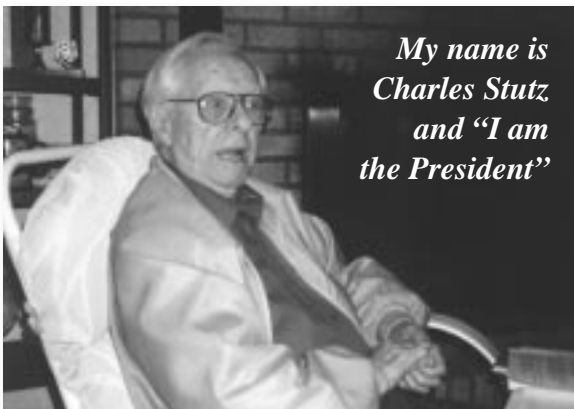
